Our Approach to Learning

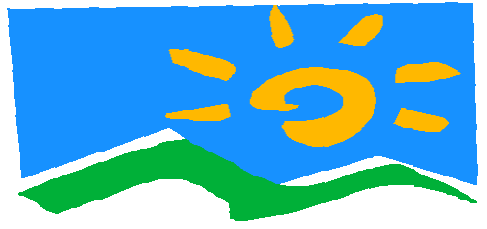

Hours of Operation

Northern Hills Day School operates from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Tuesday through Friday, August through May. We offer a 4-day a week program for all ages and a 2-day a week program option, Tues/Thurs or Wed/Fri, for toddler through older 3's. Our Pre-K program is a 4-day a week program.

Fees & Tuition

A non-refundable annual registration fee of \$100 is required for the first child and \$75 for each sibling when the registration form is returned. Supply fees are \$60 per semester for 2 day children and \$90 per semester for 4 day children. Fees are payable in September and January.
