HISPANIC MINISTRY AND OUTREACH PROGRAM

OUR PURPOSE

Since 2002, The Hispanic Outreach Ministry the purpose of this ministry is to assist United Methodist congregations in San Antonio, the Rio Grande Valley, and border areas of Texas in their mission and ministry.

OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The HMOP was launched by providing assistance to UM congregations on San Antonio's south and west sides. Our ministry group helped these churches with their Spring Break program, providing food for all members of the school and faculty for one day. The ministry also collected warm clothes and blankets and shared them with several of these churches for their use in their Emergency Clothing Services. In addition, we have given hymnals and Bibles to the Principe de Paz UMC for use in worship.

In July of 2003 the ministry carried out a mission trip to La Feria, Texas, to assist our Valley neighbors in painting their sanctuary. Nine members from Northern Hills participated and painted the church in three days. The La Feria UMC has entered a new era with help from this ministry. They have taken new pride in their church and have taken many actions to improve it further, all due to the actions of this ministry from NHC.
